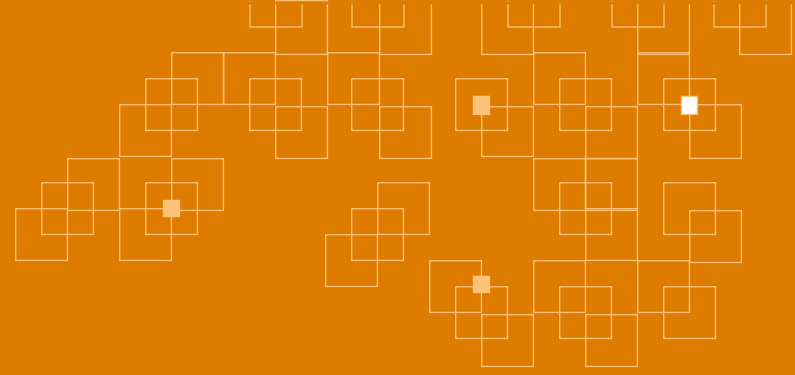




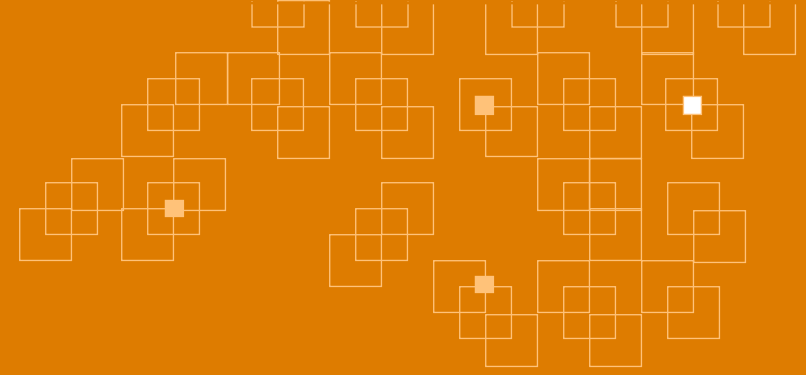

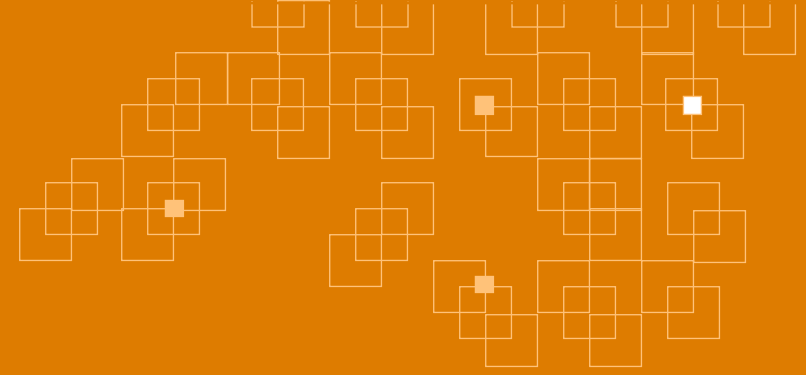

Forum Overview

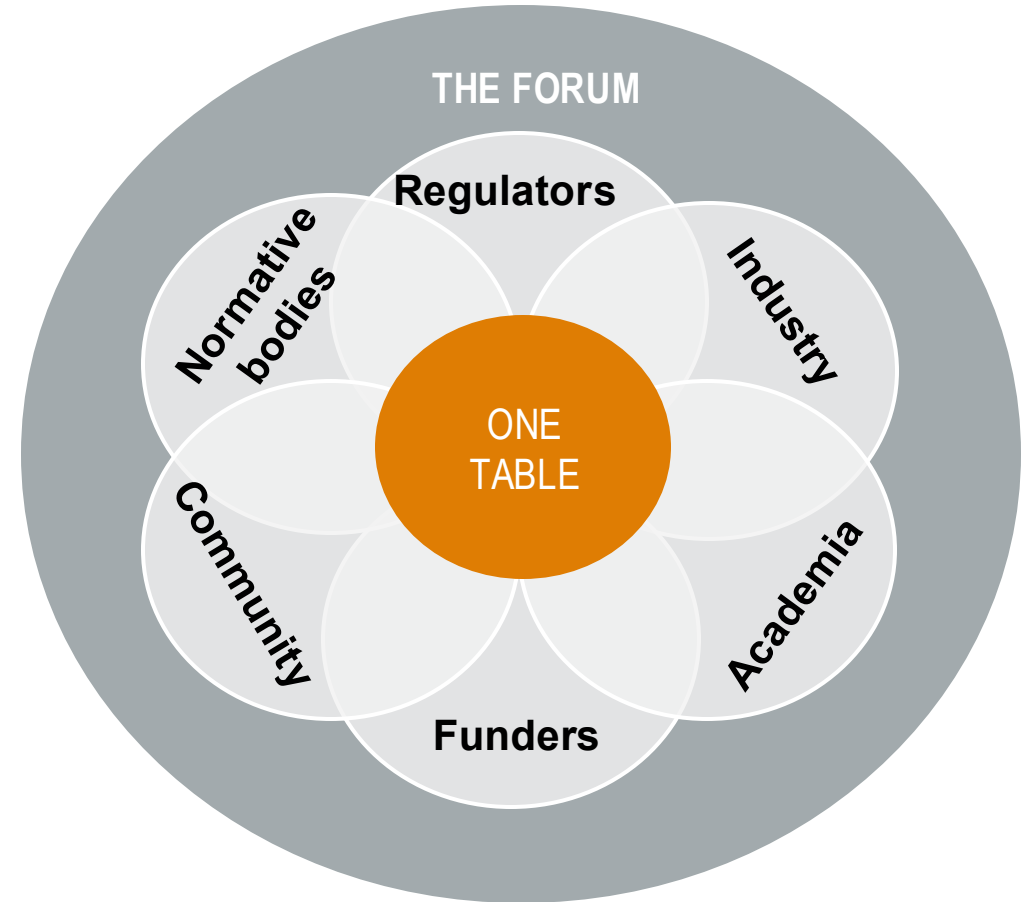
Who we are

- Identify collaborative partnerships and approaches for HIV cure research

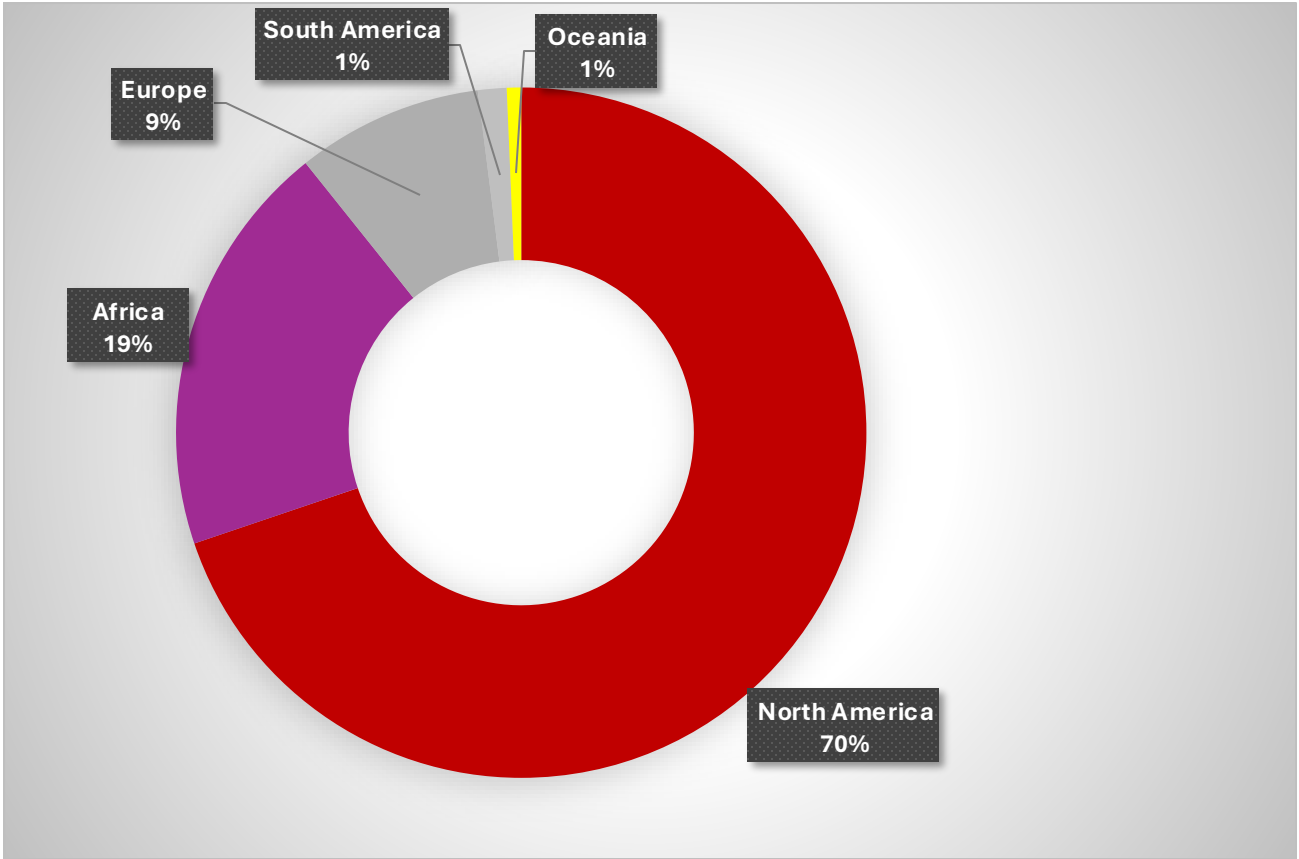

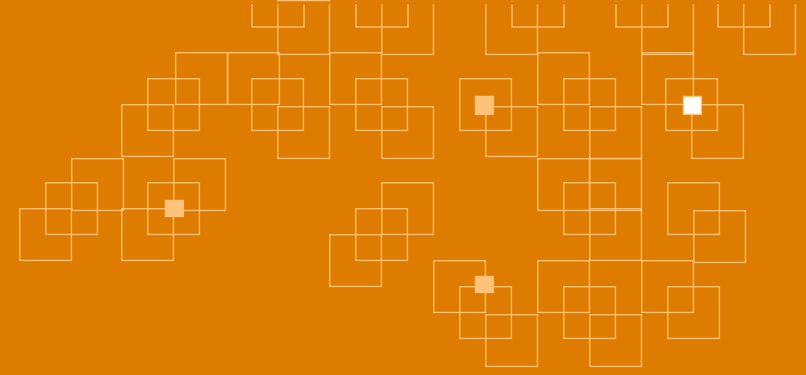


Workshop outcomes

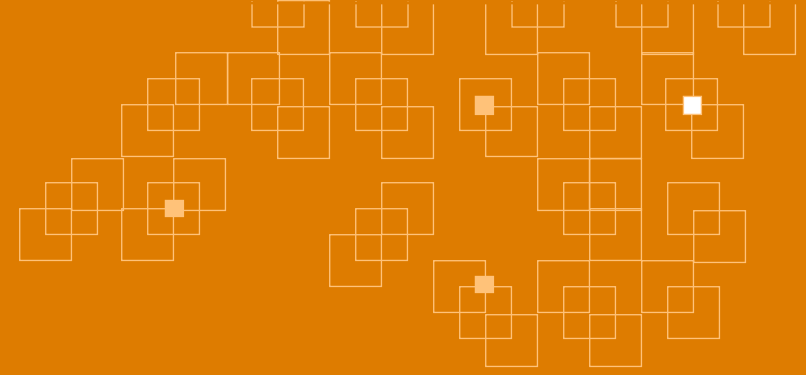

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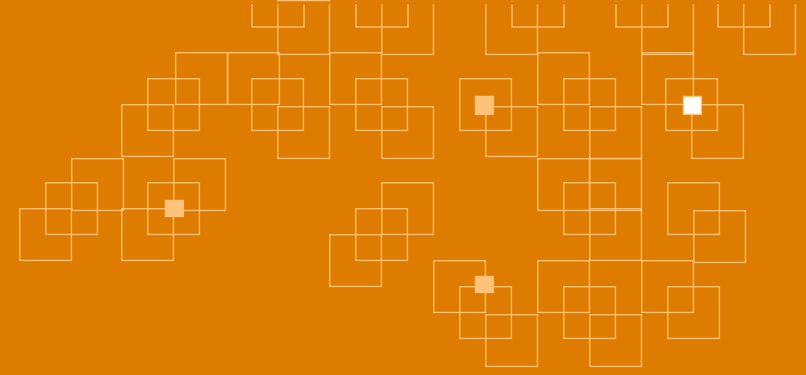
